
- A. Subject pronouns: These pronouns replace a subject, noun, or name.

- B. Infinitives: Infinitive verbs end in **–ar**, **–er**, or **–ir** and mean “to (verb)”. All infinitive verbs are composed of two parts: **stem/root + ending**.

Infinitive	Stem	Ending
llegar	lleg	ar
tomar	tom	ar
trabajar	trabaj	ar

Tercer paso (Step 3)	Attach the appropriate verb ending	yo lleg <u>o</u> tú lleg <u>as</u> él/ella/Ud. lleg <u>a</u>	nosotros lleg <u>amos</u> vosotros lleg <u>áis</u> ellos/ellas/Uds. lleg <u>an</u>

Tomar: **to drink**

tomo (I drink)	tomamos (We drink)
tomas (You drink)	tomáis (Y'all drink)
toma (He/she drinks)	toman (They drink)

Trabajar: **to work**

trabajo (I work)	trabajamos (We work)
trabajas (You work)	trabajáis (Y'all work)
trabaja (He/she works)	trabajan (They work)
