

## Present Tense Conjugations of Regular –AR verbs

A. Subject pronouns: These pronouns replace a subject, noun, or name.


B. Infinitives: Infinitive verbs end in \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, or \_\_\_\_\_ and mean “to (verb)”. All infinitive verbs are composed of two parts: \_\_\_\_\_ + \_\_\_\_\_.

B. Infinitives: Infinitive verbs end in –ar, –er, or –ir and mean “to (verb)”. All infinitive verbs are composed of two parts: stem/root + ending.

Infinitive	Stem	Ending
Dibujar	dibuj	ar
Explicar	explic	ar
Regresar	regres	ar
Viajar	viaj	ar

Bailar: **to dance**

<b>bailo</b> (I dance)	<b>bailamos</b> (We dance)
<b>bailas</b> (You dance)	<b>bailáis</b> (Y'all dance)
<b>baila</b> (He/she dances)	<b>bailan</b> (They dance)

Estudiar: **to study**

<b>estudio</b> (I study)	<b>estudiamos</b> (We study)
<b>estudias</b> (You study)	<b>estudiáis</b> (Y'all study)
<b>estudia</b> (He/she studies)	<b>estudian</b> (They study)
