

Review of Subject Pronouns and Ser

Subject Pronouns

yo (I)	nosotros (We)
tú (You)	vosotros (Y'all)
él (He) ella (She) Usted (You)	ellos (They) ellas (They) Ustedes (You all)

Subject pronouns replace a person's name

Conjugations of Ser

soy (I am)	somos (We are)
eres (You are)	sois (Y'all are)
es (He/She is) (You are)	son (They are) (You all are)

Conjugating changes the subject of a verb



yo soy (I am)	nosotros somos (We are)
tú eres (You are)	vosotros sois (Y'all are)
él es (He is) ella es (She is) Ud. es (You are)	ellos son (They are) ellas son (They are) Uds. son (You all are)

The following subject pronouns are interchangeable with the people listed.

él = one male
ella = one female
nosotros = a group of people "y yo"
nosotras = a group of females "y yo" (if "yo" is also a female)
vosotros = a group of people "y tú"
vosotras = a group of females "y tú" (if "tú" is also a female)
ellos = a group of males or males and females
ellas = a group of females
Ustedes = a group "y Ud." or a group "y tú" (if not in Spain)

Anytime "yo" is included in a group, the nosotros/nosotras form **MUST** be used!!!
