Repaso de “gustar”

- Gustar: **to be pleasing to** (**to like**)
- The subject of the sentence will come **after** “gustar”.
- An **indirect object pronoun (IOP)** will come before “gustar”.

Me	Nos
Te	Os
Le	Les

- If the subject is singular or a verb, use the **3rd person singular** form of gustar (**gusta**).
- If the subject is plural, use the **3rd person plural** form of gustar (**gustan**).
- We can emphasize/specify to whom the indirect object pronoun is referring by adding **a + name/noun/pronoun** before the IOP.

A **mí** me

A **nosotros** nos

A **ti** te

A **vosotros** os

A **él/ella/Ud.** le

A **ellos/ellas/Uds.** les

- To make a sentence negative, place **no immediately** before the IOP.

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Verbs that function like “gustar”

Aburrir: to bore

Encantar: to like very much/love (inanimate objects)

Me aburre(n)	Nos aburre(n)
Te aburre(n)	Os aburre(n)
Le aburre(n)	Les aburre(n)

Me encanta(n)	Nos encanta(n)
Te encanta(n)	Os encanta(n)
Le encanta(n)	Les encanta(n)

Faltar: to lack/need

Fascinar: to fascinate/like very much

Me falta(n)	Nos falta(n)
Te falta(n)	Os falta(n)
Le falta(n)	Les falta(n)

Me fascina(n)	Nos fascina(n)
Te fascina(n)	Os fascina(n)
Le fascina(n)	Les fascina(n)

Importar: to be important/matter to

Interesar: to interest/be interesting to

Me importa(n)	Nos importa(n)
Te importa(n)	Os importa(n)
Le importa(n)	Les importa(n)

Me interesa(n)	Nos interesa(n)
Te interesa(n)	Os interesa(n)
Le interesa(n)	Les interesa(n)

Molestar: to bother/annoy

Quedar: to be left over/to fit (clothing)

Me molesta(n)	Nos molesta(n)
Te molesta(n)	Os molesta(n)
Le molesta(n)	Les molesta(n)

Me queda(n)	Nos queda(n)
Te queda(n)	Os queda(n)
Le queda(n)	Les queda(n)

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
