

When to Use What: Subject Pronouns

<p>Yo = I</p>	<p>Nosotros = We (all males or males and females) Nosotras = We (all females) -Group of people that includes “yo”</p>
<p>Tú = You (informal)</p>	<p>Vosotros = Ya’ll (all males or males and females) Vosotras = Ya’ll (all females) -Group of people that includes “tú”, but <u>not</u> “yo” or “Usted” -Only used in Spain -Informal</p>
<p>Él = He Ella = She Usted (Ud.) = You (formal)</p>	<p>Ellos = They (all males or males and females) Ellas = They (all females) Ustedes (Uds.) = You all -Group of people that includes “Usted”, but <u>not</u> yo -Group of people that includes “tú” or “Usted” if in Central or South America -Formal in Spain</p>
